# NEWS

## Awarding of the President's Colours and University Colours

The General Sir John Kotelawala University (KDU) inherits a story of 42 years. The KDA was formally established with the aspiration of producing graduate officers and strengthening solidarity among the tri-forces of Sri Lanka. Subsequently, the academy was elevated to the status of a university in 1988, and it was ceremonially renamed as General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University (KDU) in 2007. The quality of education provided by KDU and its infrastructure facilities were enhanced in 2009 by establishing academic faculties, and in 2012 KDU opened its doors to civilian day-scholars to provide them with opportunities to pursue internationally benchmarked degrees. Presently, KDU has flourished into a fully-fledged university including eleven faculties, a University Hospital equipped with ultramodern facilities, the Southern Campus and the City Campus in keeping with its motto, 'For the Motherland Forever'. The university identifies its national responsibility of addressing issues of national significance through teaching, learning, research and innovation.



On August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the President of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, His Excellency Ranil Wickremesinghe, awarded the President's Colours and University Colours to General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University in recognition of its four decades of exceptional excellence in maintaining important aspects of military education: discipline, training and knowledge. The president expressed his strong belief that KDU authorities and staff would protect and safeguard the status of the university by respecting the President's Colours and University Colours awarded. Addressing the gathering, the President further appreciated the valiant service rendered by KDU officers during the height of the civil war in the country. He highlighted that KDU has gained local and international acclaim and thus the need for protecting the university as an essential education stake holder of the higher education sector in Sri Lanka. Further, he appreciated the enrolment of civil students for KDU degree programmes, extending higher education opportunities in dynamic study streams.





“The world is changing and in future we won’t see the sort of war that we have experienced in the past. New technology and new knowledge is developing. Especially the war is not limited to land, air and sea. Cyber technology is also developing. Also, climate change should be taken into consideration when you engage in your duties,” the President stated.

Major General Milinda Peiris, RWP RSP VSV USP ndc psc MPhil, Vice Chancellor of KDU made a solemn declaration on behalf of all staff of KDU and its student population pledging to protect and safeguard the President’s Colours and the University Colours awarded.

# General Convocation of General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University 2022



The General Convocation 2022 of General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University was ceremonially held at the BMICH on 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> of November 2022, and its first three sessions were successfully completed with the participation of the Vice Chancellor, Major General Milinda Peiris RWP RSP VSV USP ndc whilst the Chancellor, General Gerard Hector de Silva (Retired) RWP VSV USP ndc graced the occasion as the Chief Guest with eminent academia.

The final session of General Convocation 2022 of KDU was held on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2022, and Hon. Ranil Wickramasinghe, the President of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka graced the occasion as the chief guest with many other dignitaries who witnessed the grand occasion. With 40 years of reputation in the international realm, going beyond the restriction of offering degrees to only military personnel, KDU broadened its scope and opened its doors to qualified civil students in 2009 to realize their dream of obtaining a degree in a disciplined environment on par with other local or international universities.



Having a student base of 6055 undergraduates in-house at present, General Gerald Hector de Silva (Retired) RWP VSV USP ndc, the Chancellor of the University, conferred 1619 graduands from all faculties and affiliated military institutions and 269 Masters graduands and postgraduate Diploma holders, consisting of Tri-Services, Police as well as Executive Officers in Public and Private Sector, from the Faculty of Graduate Studies and affiliated institutions, at the 2022 Convocation.

Officer Cadet, C/5510 WMJC Weerakoon, NRE 4144 Sub Lt SASV Hapuarachchi and Fg Off EWDH Egodawaththa were awarded the best Cadet Officers from the Army, Navy and Air Force respectively. # 15<sup>TH</sup> INTERNATIONAL RESEARCH CONFERENCE (IRC 2022)



## Inaugural session

The Inaugural session of the 15<sup>th</sup> International Research Conference 2022 of General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University was successfully held on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2022 at the Faculty of Graduate Studies auditorium, General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University, Ratmalana. The event's welcome address was delivered by Major General Milinda Peiris RWP RSP VSV USP ndc psc MPhil (Ind) PGDM, the Vice Chancellor of General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University.

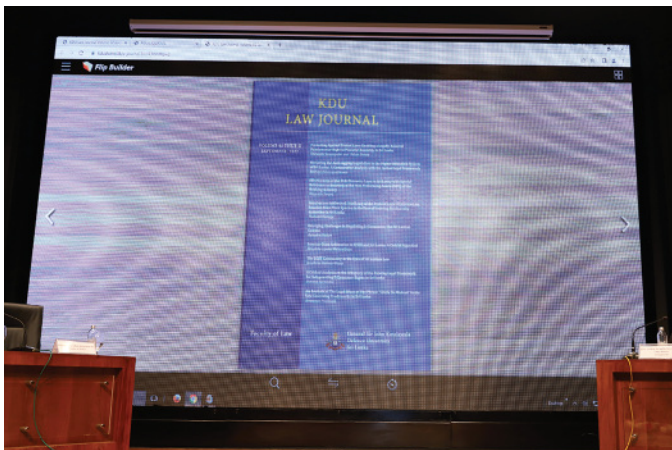


# From 'The Vendor of Sweets' to 'Rasa Kevili Velenda': Translation Transcending Cultures

## Story of Colours

‘Colour’ is the name given to flags that represent the regiments of an Army. In the military, Colours originally acted as a rallying point for the troops and for locating the Commander on the battlefield amidst the dust, smoke, noise and confusion of battle. It was the focal point of a regiment even if the commander was killed, the light of hope was still there, whilst the Colours remained intact and on the edge of defeat the troops would rally around and follow the colours as the beacon of last defence.

The application of the word ‘Colour’ to such insignia, dates from 16<sup>th</sup> century. It was formalized in the armies of Europe in the middle ages with standards being emblazoned with the commander’s Coat of Arms . However the practice has been carried out since ancient times originating in Egypt around 5000 years ago.

The term ‘Colours’ encompasses four distinctive forms of honourable insignia that symbolize a regiment’s spirit. Apart from the Coat of Arms of the commander, the colours borne on them are the battle honours and badges granted to the unit in commemoration of gallant deeds performed by members of the unit from the time their unit was raised. Four distinctive forms of Honourable Insignia that are currently in use are Standards, Guidons, Colours and Banners. The full history of a regiment is contained within written records, but as these are not portable in a convenient form, the Colours, emblazoned with distinctions for long and honourable service, are something that proudly symbolizes the regiments history, and creates a feeling of solidarity in soldiers and ex-soldiers alike.

Today Colours are no longer carried into the battlefield due to the advancement of technology and different complexities in modern warfare. They are now used as a part of a regiment’s tradition and used in events as a celebrative symbol of recognition.

In Sri Lanka eligibility for ‘President’s Colours’ is considered the highest honour that any military establishment or a wing could achieve from the Head of the State in recognition of exceptional service to the nation. Thus this magnificent award has been bestowed upon General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University (KDU) on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August 2022.



The message from His Excellency Ranil Wickramasinghe president of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka and Commander and Chief of the armed forces asserted that,

“...Thus having recognized the enormous contribution to the national security, concurrent contribution to the defence services, and national development of Sri Lanka by grooming an educated workforce with admirable values and multifaceted skills in various disciplines, I extend my highest appreciation to KDU by bestowing President’s colours and university colours to General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University. May it be a tribute to those who contributed to its formation and growth in diverse ways over the years and to those men and women produced through its portals and served the nation through sweat and blood.”

# PRESIDENT'S COLOURS FLAG

The President's Colours is a specially designed national flag of Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka presented by His Excellency the President of Sri Lanka to General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University of Sri Lanka. The flag's colors are embroidered on a Ribbon made of silk thread mixed with durable fabric, with gold thread, and emblazoned with the state emblem of Sri Lanka in silver and gold on two green and orange stripes on the left side of the flag. The image of the Lion and four Bo leaves are embroidered with gold thread. The flag is 125.7 cm long and 102 cm wide, trimmed with gold tassels.

The President's colours awarded to the General Sir John Kotelawala Defence University is a dignified and proud symbol of the service rendered by all University Officers and Officer Cadets to the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.



# UNIVERSITY COLOURS FLAG

The KDU colours flag is a symbolic composition representing the Tri-Services with three different coloured stripes as Orange for the Sri Lanka Army, Dark Blue for Sri Lanka Navy and Light Blue for Sri Lanka Air Force. Further, KDU crest in the flag symbolizes KDU's role of serving the motherland by catering to the professional and academic needs of the Tri-Services of the country, as the first ever Defence and Security-oriented educational institution in Sri Lanka. The KDU crest incorporates the three emblems; the two cross swords, the anchor and the two wings to represent Sri Lanka Army, Sri Lanka Navy and Sri Lanka Air Force respectively. The torch in the middle of the crest symbolizes the focus of the institution; 'Education'. The KDU Motto 'For the motherland forever' engraved in the bottom of the crest and the state emblem on the top of the crest signifies the KDU's unwavering allegiance to the nation.



Flag masts of the two colour flags are made of brass coated with 18 carat gold and are decorated depicting the state symbol on top of the President's colour flag mast, and KDU symbol on the University Colour flag mast. The two masts consist of blooming two lotuses representing purity, two spherical structures depicting all life on earth, four lotus petals fixed to the spheres indicating four directions, four blocks attached embedded with 40 blue gems representing 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of KDU and 40 years of service to the nation and four rings at the bottom of the structure that depict Metta, Karuna, Muditha and Upeksha.

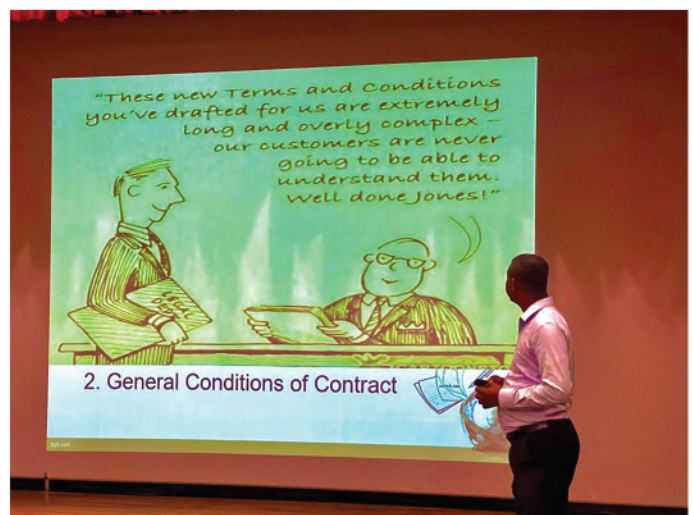
